² This amendment reduces funding from the general fund for reorganization bonuses and joint powers incentives by \$1,500,000 from \$2,000,000 for bonuses and incentives to \$500,000 for bonuses only. The Senate provided funding of \$2,000,000 from the general fund for reorganization bonuses and joint powers incentives, and the executive budget recommended funding of \$1,000,000 from the general fund for reorganization bonuses and joint powers incentives.
