


¹The 2005-07 appropriation is based on 340.05 FTE positions. Section 6 of Senate Bill No. 2020 (2005) authorizes the State Board of Higher Education to adjust FTE positions as needed. A total of 5.03 FTE positions were added pursuant to this section.

²The Main Research Center allocated \$150,000 of general fund appropriation to North Dakota State University Extension Service (\$66,000) and the branch research centers (\$84,000) for critical needs. Section 5 of Senate Bill No. 2020 (2005) authorizes that upon approval of the State Board of Agricultural Research and Education and appropriate branch research directors, the director of the Main Research Center may transfer appropriation authority within the North Dakota State University Extension Service, Northern Crops Institute, Main Research Center, and branch research centers.

Other Sections in Bill

Section 4 of House Bill No. 1020 provides that, in addition to the amount appropriated as special funds, any other income received from federal acts, private grants, gifts, and donations, or from other sources received by the Main Research Center is appropriated for the purpose designated in the act, grant, gift, or donation for the 2007-09 biennium.

Section 5 of House Bill No. 1020 authorizes the transfer of appropriation authority between the Main Research Center, the branch research centers, NDSU Extension Service, and Northern Crops Institute.

Section 6 of House Bill No. 1020 authorizes the State Board of Higher Education to adjust or increase full-time equivalent positions for the Main Research Center and report any adjustments to the Office of Management and Budget.

Section 7 of House Bill No. 1020 authorizes the carryover of any unexpended general fund appropriation and excess income received by the Main Research Center.

Section 8 of House Bill No. 1020 provides that Phase II of the research greenhouse complex (\$9,000,000), Carrington Research Center headquarters office (\$465,000), Hettinger Research Center headquarters office (\$222,750) and North Central Research Center office (\$420,000) projects are an emergency.
