



The House amended House Bill No. 1106 to increase session pay from \$130 to \$140 per day and interim meeting pay from \$100 to \$125 per day but did not appropriate the additional \$291,510 needed for these increases. ## **Related Legislation**

House Bill No. 1106 - This bill increases legislators' session pay by \$15 per day, from \$125 to \$140 per day, and interim meeting pay by \$25 per day, from \$100 to \$125 per day.

House Bill No. 1107 - This bill increases the state mileage reimbursement rate from 37.5 to 45 cents per mile.

Senate Bill No. 2310 - This bill provides a continuing appropriation to the Legislative Assembly to spend donated funds received by the Legislative Assembly.
