Item Description

One-time funding - In Section 7 of 2009 Senate Bill No. 2003, the Legislative Assembly identified \$59,233,248 from the general fund and \$10.4 million from the permanent oil tax trust fund for one-time funding items for the North Dakota University System. Of this amount, \$300,000 from the general fund is for the construction of a greenhouse at the Towner State Nursery and \$45,576 from the general fund is for Forest Service deferred maintenance. This amount is not to be considered part of the agency's base budget for preparing the 2011-13 executive budget, and the Forest Service is to report to the Appropriations Committees during the 2011 legislative session on the use of this funding.

Federal funding replacement - Section 14 of Senate Bill No. 2003 provides that the Forest Service appropriation includes \$826,284 from the general fund that may only be used on a dollar-for-dollar basis to offset federal funding reductions.

Status/Result

The following is a summary of the status of the Forest Service's one-time funding items for the 2009-11 biennium:

- Deferred maintenance The agency anticipates using all funding provided for deferred maintenance.
- Towner State Nursery greenhouse The agency anticipates using all the funding provided for construction of a greenhouse at the Towner State Nursery. The project is estimated to be completed in February 2011.

The Forest Service anticipates the entire amount of \$826,284 will be used during the 2009-11 biennium to offset federal funding reductions.
