<sup>2</sup> This amendment reduces salaries and wages funding to recognize anticipated savings from vacant positions and employee turnover.

<sup>3</sup> This amendment removes funding added in the executive budget for state employee salary equity adjustments.

<sup>4</sup> This amendment decreases funding for operating expenses by \$20,000 from the general fund.

<sup>5</sup> This amendment adds a section to amend North Dakota Century Code Section 16.1-01-15 to provide that any interest earnings on the election fund must be used for the exclusive purpose of carrying out activities of the Help America Vote Act of 2002 and provides for a one-time transfer of \$25,000 from the general fund to the election fund for the imputed interest earnings allocable to the amount of nonfederal funds contained in the fund.

<sup>2</sup> This amendment restores funding for salaries and wages removed by the House to recognize anticipated savings from vacant positions and employee turnover.

<sup>3</sup> This amendment restores salary equity funding removed by the House.

<sup>4</sup> Funding removed by the House for operating expenses is restored.

<sup>5</sup> Funding of \$30,000 from the general fund is added for the state's 5 percent match for approximately \$500,000 of federal funds to be deposited in the election reform fund.

<sup>6</sup> This amendment provides that, subject to Budget Section approval, the Secretary of State may borrow up to \$3,400,698 from the Bank of North Dakota which is appropriated to the Secretary of State for implementing the North Dakota business development engine computer project during the 2009-11 biennium if additional revenues from corporate charters are anticipated to be sufficient to repay the loan and accrued interest.

This amendment also provides that any unexpended and unobligated balance remaining in the Secretary of State's general services operating fund on June 30, 2009, is not subject to the provisions of North Dakota Century Code Section 54-09-08, and any unexpended funds are available and may be expended by the Secretary of State during the 2009-11 biennium for the database and processing platform migration project.

<sup>3</sup> Funding removed by the House for operating expenses is restored. This funding was also restored by the Senate.

<sup>4</sup> Funding of \$30,000 from the general fund is added for the state's 5 percent match for approximately \$500,000 of federal funds to be deposited in the election reform fund. This funding was also added by the Senate.

<sup>5</sup> This amendment provides that, subject to Budget Section approval, the Secretary of State may borrow up to \$3,400,698 from the Bank of North Dakota which is appropriated to the Secretary of State for implementing the North Dakota business development engine computer project during the 2009-11 biennium if additional revenues from corporate charters are anticipated to be sufficient to repay the loan and accrued interest. This contingent appropriation was also added by the Senate.

This amendment provides that any unexpended and unobligated balance remaining in the Secretary of State's general services operating fund on June 30, 2009, is not subject to the provisions of North Dakota Century Code Section 54-09-08, and any unexpended funds are available and may be expended by the Secretary of State during the 2009-11 biennium for the database and processing platform migration project. This change was also made by the Senate.
