ADOPT, AMEND AND REPEAL ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

TAKE NOTICE that the Bureau of Criminal Investigation will hold a public hearing to address proposed amendments to N.D. Admin. Code Article 10-12 at 9:00 A.M. on Thursday, November 19, 2009, at Comfort Inn, 1030 E Interstate Avenue, Bismarck North Dakota. The purpose of the proposed rules is to implement statutes. The proposed rules address the application, obtaining and maintaining of concealed firearm or dangerous weapon licenses in the State of North Dakota.
