NOTICE OF INTENT TO CREATE ADMINISTRATIVE RULES RELATING TO N.D.A.C. CHAPTER 75-02-01.3 CHILD CARE ASSISTANCE

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota Department of Human Services will hold a public hearing to address proposed amendments to N.D. Admin. Code Chapter 75-02-01.3 at 3:30 p.m. on Wednesday, December 9, 2009, in Bismarck, N.D. in the AV Room – Room 210, located on the second floor of the Judicial Wing of the State Capitol.

The proposed creation of N.D. Admin. Code Chapter 75-02-01.3, Child Care Assistance, is necessary to comply with the provisions of 2009 House Bill No. 1090. The proposed chapter will have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.

Chapter 75-02-01.3, is created to comply with North Dakota Century Code chapter 50-33 as created and enacted by 2009 House Bill No. 1090. This chapter is created to set forth the administration of the Child Care Assistance Program and includes rules on decision and notice, closing of a case, available benefits, background check information, payments to providers, treatment of income, disregarded income, deduction for child support and spousal support, parental choice of caretaker or provider, intentional program violations and penalties, and reconsideration and appeal requests.

Copies of the proposed rules are available for review at county social services offices and at human service centers. Copies of the proposed rules and the regulatory analysis relating to these rules may be requested by telephoning (701) 328-2311.
