NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT AN ADMINISTRATIVE RULE

TAKE NOTICE that the Superintendent of Public Instruction will hold a public hearing to take public comment on a proposed new rule to the North Dakota Administrative Code beginning at 10:00 a.m. and continuing until 12:00 p.m., or until no further testimony is offered, whichever occurs first, on January 15, 2009, on the 2nd Floor of the State Library, in the Special Education Office Conference Room 203, 604 East Boulevard Avenue, Bismarck, North Dakota 58505. The purpose of the proposed rules and the time for hearing are set out below.

Adopt a new section to Article 67-23 Special Education creating two exceptions to the sixty-day timeframe for initial evaluations that will allow additional time for extreme weather or unavailability of evaluators

The proposed new section to Article 67-23 will allow an exception to the sixty-day requirement for an initial evaluation when extreme weather conditions occur or when an appropriate evaluator is not available in the state. It is not expected that the proposed rulemaking will have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.
