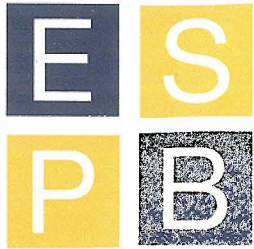

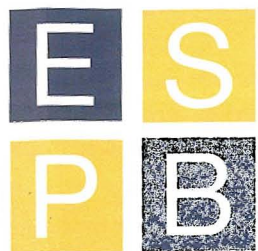

ADOPT, AMEND, OR REPEAL ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

TAKE NOTICE that the Education Standards and Practices Board will hold a public hearing to address proposed new, amendments to, or repeal of N.D. Admin. Code 67.1 at 1:30 p.m. on December 9, 2009 in the Lewis and Clark Room, 600 East Boulevard, Bismarck, ND. The purpose of the proposed rules and amendments is to implement statues and comply with federal law. The proposed rules and amendments addresses teacher education program approval, educator licensure, professional development, and professional practices. The proposed rules and amendments is not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.
