**NOTICE OF INTENT TO
AMEND AND REPEAL ADMINISTRATIVE RULES**

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota State Board for Nursing Home Administrators will hold a public hearing to address proposed amendments to and repeal of a rule in N.D. Admin. Code chapter 55-02-01 at 9:00 a.m. Central Time on Thursday, January 7, 2010 at 1900 North 11th Street, Bismarck North Dakota 58501. The purpose of the proposed amendments is to update and clarify the rules governing nursing home administrator licensure. The proposed amendments address criminal history record checks, a state nursing home administrator exam and fees. The proposed changes are not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.

The proposed rules may be reviewed at the office of the North Dakota State Board for Nursing Home Administrators, 1900 North 11th Street, Bismarck, North Dakota 58501. A copy of the proposed rules may be requested by writing the above address or calling 701-222-4867. Written or oral comments on the proposed rules sent to the above address or telephone number and received by January 22, 2010 will be fully considered.
