NOTICE OF INTENT TO AMEND ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota Department of Health will hold a public hearing to

address proposed amendments to N.D. Admin. Code Article 33-10 at 10 a.m. on Thursday,

April 29, 2010, at 918 East Divide Avenue. The proposed amendments address a legislative

mandate to provide training requirements for limited scope X-ray operators and adopt the

applicable Nuclear Regulatory Commission rules by reference. The X-ray rules reflect all X-ray

registrants and service providers. The adopted Nuclear Regulatory Commission rules affect all

state radioactive material licensees and those Nuclear Regulatory Commission and Agreement

State licensees entering North Dakota under reciprocity. The proposed amendments are

expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000 over the six-year

period.

The proposed rules may be reviewed at the office of the Department of Health, 918 East Divided

Avenue, 2nd Floor, Bismarck, North Dakota. A copy of the proposed rules and/or a regulatory

analysis may be requested by writing the above address or calling (701)328-5188. Written

comments on the proposed rules sent to the above address or by email (ram@nd.gov) and

received by May 10, 2010 will be fully considered.
