
NOTICE OF INTENT TO AMEND ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota Department of Health will hold a public hearing to address proposed amendments to N.D. Administrative Code chapter 33-06-01, Conditions Designated as Reportable. The hearing will be held at 1:00 p.m. on Thursday, March 25, 2010, in Room 212, Judicial Wing, 600 East Boulevard Avenue, Bismarck, ND. The purpose of the proposed amendments is to clarify terminology and update reportable conditions. The amendment is not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000. No taking of real property is involved in these rulemaking actions.

The proposed amendments may be reviewed at the office of the State Health Department, 600 East Boulevard Avenue, Bismarck, ND 58505-0200. A copy of the proposed amendments may be requested by writing the above address or calling 701-328-2378. Written or oral comments on the proposed amendments sent to the above address or phone number and received by April 8, 2010 will be fully considered.
