NOTICE OF INTENT TO AMEND ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota Department of Health will hold a public hearing to address proposed amendments to North Dakota Administrative Code Chapter 33-24-08, Technical Standards and Corrective Action Requirements For Owners and Operators of Underground Storage Tanks, at 1:30 p.m. CDT on Wednesday, July 14, 2010, in the 4th Floor Conference Room of the North Dakota Health Department, 918 E. Divide Ave., Bismarck, North Dakota 58501-1947.

The purpose of the amendments is to include training requirements for three distinct classes of operators who operate and maintain regulated underground storage tank systems. The amendments are necessary to comply with mandates contained in the federal Energy Policy Act of 2005. The proposed amendments are not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.
