NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT AND AMEND ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota Racing Commission will hold a public hearing to address proposed new rules in and amendments to N.D. Admin. Code article 69.5-01 at 9:00 a.m. on Wednesday, September 22, 2010 in the Fort Lincoln Room, 1st Floor, State Capitol, 600 East Boulevard Avenue, Bismarck, North Dakota.

The purpose of the proposed rules and amendments are to amend and establish regulatory requirements and clarify rules. The proposed new rules and amendments address pari-mutuel wagering, simulcasting, account wagering, and breeder's fund. The proposed rules and amendments are not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.
