**NOTICE OF INTENT TO
ADOPT A NEW ADMINISTRATIVE RULE
RELATING TO WORKFORCE SAFETY & INSURANCE
AND NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
Out-of-state coverage for law enforcement training.**

TAKE NOTICE that Workforce Safety & Insurance (WSI) will conduct a public hearing to address a proposed new rule, section 92-01-02-22.2 of the N.D. Administrative Code, at 9:00 a.m. on Wednesday, May 18, 2011, at the WSI Board Room, Century Center, 1600 E. Century Avenue, Bismarck, North Dakota, at which time and place all persons will be heard regarding the proposed new rule to the North Dakota Administrative Code:

The purpose of the proposed new rule, Administrative Code Section 92-01-02-22.2, relating to out-of-state coverage for law enforcement training is as follows: to allow for coverage, by written agreement, to North Dakota employers for their employees engaged in law enforcement training outside the state for a limited period of time. This proposed new rule is not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.

The proposed new rule may be reviewed or copied on any working day between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. at Workforce Safety & Insurance, 1600 East Century Avenue, Bismarck, North Dakota. This proposed new rule does not require a regulatory analysis, small entity regulatory analysis, or small entity economic impact statement.
