NOTICE OF INTENT TO [ADOPT, AMEND OR REPEAL] ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota State Electrical Board will hold a public hearing to address proposed new rules and amendments to N.D. Admin. Code Article 24-02 at <u>1:15</u> <u>p.m. on July 19, 2012</u>, at the Red River Room, State Capitol, Bismarck, North Dakota. The purpose of the proposed new rules and amendments is to ensure that master or class B electricians are not issuing wiring certificates while having no oversight on the job. The proposed new rules and amendments address:

• 24-02-01-02(3): Adds a requirement that the master or class B electrician be engaged full time in the operation of a shop or business doing electrical work.

The proposed new rules and amendments are not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.00.

The proposed new rules and amendments may be reviewed at the office of the N.D. State Electrical Board, 1929 N. Washington Street, Suite A-1, P.O. Box 7335, Bismarck, North Dakota 58507. A copy of the proposed new rules and amendments and/or a regulatory analysis may be requested by writing the above address or calling (701) 328-9522. Written or oral comments on the proposed new rules and amendments sent to the above address or telephone number and received by July 29, 2012 will be fully considered.
