House Bill 246 increases the fee for a certified copy of a birth and death certificate from \$1 (one) to \$2 (two).
Fees collected and deposited in the State's General Fund for certified copies for the past four years are as follows:
1965 - \$28,332 1966 - 34,093 1968 - 32,082 (11 months' collection)
If House Bill 49, which requires a birth certificate to secure a driver's license, becomes law we estimate 9,000 additional requests for birth certificates per year with additional

\$18,000 in collection of fees. Therefore we estimate that House Bill 246 could increase

income to the General Fund at a rate of \$32,000 to \$50,000 per year.
