Increasing the costs of vital records from \$1.00 to \$2.00 will double our average
yearly income of \$37,500 per year to \$75,000 per year. Making a permissive charge
for record searching, we estimate will add an additional \$6,000 per year income.
Therefore increasing the cost of the records and making a charge for record searching
will increase the yearly income from Vital Statistics in the amount of \$43,500 per year
or \$87,000 per biennium. If H. B. 1347 is adopted, the total income from birth and
death records and record searching is estimated to be approximately \$162,000 per
biennium.
