The fiscal effect of this Resolution is as follows:
We are presently expending between \$30,000 and \$50,000 through Title I of the Higher Education Act of 1963 for the gathering of basic data. There is a real question as to whether this expenditure will continue to be authorized by the Federal Government for the gathering of basic data. The emphasis is now shifting to in depth application of the basic data, hence if the authorization is cut off, the cost to the state will be from \$30,000 to \$50,000 just for gathering the basic data. In depth studies will cost approximately another estimated \$35,000 to \$45,000.
