Chapter 37-16 of the North Dakota Century Code requires the Adjutant General to compile and maintain a record of burial places within this State of all soldiers, sailors and marines who served in the military or naval forces of the United States in time of war.	
37-16-06 stipulates that in order to comply with this law, the Adjutant General "shall use the unexpended balance remaining in the returned soldier's fund, or such part there as may be required."	
Such a fund (returned soldier's fund) does not exist and has not existed for many years. Therefore sufficient funds are not available to comply with the law.	•
There would be no fiscal involvement relative to the repeal of this Law.
