The elimination of the 4% sales tax on coal, electricity and natural gas would reduce State General Fund revenue by \$9,593,780. (See Exhibit 1).* The elimination of the 2% excise tax on heating fuel and L P gas would reduce the Highway Page Typic Land by \$1,050,703 (See Exhibit 1).</pre> Administrative costs are estimated to
