HB 1254 is a general provision regarding the cancellation, revocation, suspension or rescission of a motor vehicle registration or a certificate of title to a motor vehicle. State law now provides for such hearings in specific instances. The need for a general provision is necessitated by proposals pending before the Legislative Assembly regarding no-fault insurance and inspection of motor vehicles, both of which make reference to registration revocation. The fiscal impact of HB 1254 will depend on the number of registrations which might be affected by the no-fault insurance and vehicle inspection proposals, and, consequently it is not possible to estimate the fiscal affect of HB 1254.
