The total cost of this program would be \$60,000 during the Biennium. The program would be funded by a federal LEAA grant to the Attorney General from the Law Enforcement Council. The grant would be funded on a 90/10 basis with \$54,000 Federal Funds and a General Fund appropriation of \$6,000. The grant would provide funds to hire one professional and one secretary, and to provide support costs for the program.

It is estimated that this uniform records system could be developed and adopted by local law enforcement during 1975-77 biennium so that continuation costs in the future would be borne by the local unit of government.
