It would also reduce county distributed revenue from the \$6,422,000 anticipated under present law to \$4,174,048 for the 1975-77 Biennium, or a decrease of \$2,247,952. Oue to lack of information it would not be statistically reliable to estimate the fiscal effect of the amendment to include a \$25,000 insurance exemption.
