State Laboratories Department sanitarians currently inspect retail food stores. Enforcement of Senate Bill #2270 would require some additional time per inspection. The added time would amount to an estimated expense of approximately \$3,000 per biennum.
The potential savings to N.D. consumers under Senate Bill 2270 by far outweighs the cost of administration. It would not be unreasonable to expect a savings of 2¢ per item on a 50¢ item if unit pricing information is provided. If a family of four spends \$200 per month for food the potential savings to consumers in our State reaches a conservative estimate of a minimum of 8 million dollars per year.
