This fiscal note shall be in two parts. Part one will address Section 1 of HB-1493, and part two will address Section 2 of HB-1493.

Part 1. Section 1 of HB-1493 proposes to limit the water use fee authority of the State Water Commission to the anticipated cost of filing and processing water use permit applications. The Attorney General, in an opinion dated December 27, 1978, stated that the State Water Commission does not have any authority to establish water use fees for such purposes, but rather, such authority was limited as follows:

> The authority of the State Water Commission to provide for the "sale of waters" is limited to those waters which the Commission has itself appropriated and reserved by the construction, operation and control of "works" (project faciltiies) authorized by Chapter 61-02 of the North Dakota Century Code, and made available for delivery to water users. The amount of monies raised by such "sale" would be limited to the service costs of making water available through storage and delivery "works." (facilities)

In other words, the State Water Commission can provide for the sale of waters for water storage and delivery facilities which it has constructed, and for which it has secured a water permit, to amortize the costs of the project.

Thus, the effect of the proposed amendment to subsection 2 of Section 61-02-14 of the North Dakota Century Code is that the State of North Dakota would be required to pay all costs of any water storage and delivery project constructed by the State Water Commission, and the beneficiaries could not be charged for any of the costs. Since project costs are unknown, cost to the State cannot be determined.

Part 2. Section 2 of HB-1493 proposes to limit the authority of the State Engineer to issue permits subject to fees to the "anticipated cost of filing and processing the permit applications". The Attorney General, in his opinion, stated that the authority of the State Engineer to issue

water permits subject to fees is limited to those amounts for planning and administration of the <u>regulation</u> of the allocation and appropriation of the waters of the state.

Attached is a summary of water permit application fee revenues, and the "administrative" costs, including salaries, travel, vehicle expense and indirect charges, incurred in the processing of water permit applications. Please keep in mind that this summary sheet does not reflect any costs for planning and research of water sources which are necessary before water permits can be granted.
