Narrative:

If enacted as amended, the fiscal effect of <u>Section 3</u> of House Bill 1365 would be to <u>decrease</u> refunds by an estimated \$1,200,000 for the 1981-83 biennium. Section 4 would <u>decrease</u> state general fund revenue by an estimated \$32,000,000 for the 1981-83 biennium. Highway distribution fund revenues would <u>increase</u> by an estimated \$25,200,000 and there would be \$8,000,000 transferred to a township road fund. This assumes that House Bill 1365 applies to taxes levied after July 1, 1981, and that revenues from the oil and gas production tax to the township road fund will be equal to \$4,000,000 annually less the expected revenues from withholding one cent of the refund on gasoline and special fuels.
