In the following space note the fiscal effect in dollars of the legislative proposal:

Narrative:

This bill increases the daily expense reimbursement for each legislator retroactive to January 1, 1981, from \$70 to \$85 per day. Based on 88 legislative days the additional cost for the 1981 and 1983 Legislative Assemblies will be \$396,000. The 1982 Organizational Session (five days) increased reimbursement would total \$11,250.

This bill also increases the monthly expense reimbursement received by legislators from \$150 to \$180 per month. Since this increase is retroactive to January 1, 1981, the additional cost for the 1981 and 1983 Legislative Assemblies will be \$135,000.

This bill also increases the per diem reimbursement legislators receive for attending interim Legislative Council meetings from \$52 to \$62.50 r day costing \$48,496.

The total additional general funds needed pursuant to House Bill No. 1494 are \$590,746.
