In the following space note the fiscal effect in dollars of the legislative proposal:

Narrative:

This bill would limit cost to a school district to two and one-half times the state average cost of education when it is necessary to send a student out-of-district within the state for special education instruction. It would require that state special education funds pay any amount over two and one-half times the cost paid by the district for instruction and boarding care. Transportation would be paid under the rules and regulations of the Department of Public Instruction. About 115 students are now attending school districts outside their own multidistrict units.
