Narrative:

We estimate that approximately 70,000 students are not being transported under the present foundation aid law.

Assuming schools have 175 days of school and that the average attendance is 95%, the cost of transporting all students is computed as follows:

> 70,000 students X 175 days 12,250,000 X .95 attendance 11,637,500 X .15 per pupil per day \$1,745,625.

Reimbursement is made the year following the transportation so the 1981-82 transportation would be reimbursed during the second year of the next biennium, so the appropriation would only need to be for one year this time.
