Narrative:

There was very little base information available to assess the fiscal effect. It was estimated that 60% of the 14.5% married persons residing in nursing homes would have assets of \$25,000 or less. We applied 14.5% to private-pay nursing home and intermediate care patients estimated for 1981-1983 biennium. Cost per day of care was based on social service estimates for 1981-1983 biennium of what social service board pays per day. Cost of other medical services in addition to skilled nursing home and intermediate care was based on six month data ending March 31, 1980, for recipients age 65 and over with annual inflation factor applied.
