In the following space note the fiscal effect in dollars of the legislative proposal:
<pre>Narrative:</pre>
The projected impact of Senate Bill 2370 varies, dependent upon the size of type, number of columns, and size of columns chosen by the various newspapers. For example, under the provisions of Senate Bill 2370, a paper publishing a legal notice in an 8 to 9 pica column would receive 22% less than under the current rate - whereas a paper publishing the same legal notice in a 14 to 15 pica column could receive 27% more than under the current rate. The rate of increase or decrease is dependent upon the type of notice printed. Currently there are 18 newspapers in the 8 to 9 pica category and 49 newspapers in the 14 to 15 pica
category.
Since the volume of legal notices published is not known, the total fiscal impact is not possible to project.
