Narrative:

In the time given to prepare this fiscal note it is impossible to determine accurately which companies would meet the definition of "independent producer" as stated in HB 1089. Our projections encompass a range based on test data from two quarters of production and a review of all North Dakota producers. HB 1089, if enacted into law, would decrease revenues to the State General Fund approximately \$14,010,000 to \$19,110,000, decrease revenues to the School Aid Fund approximately \$28,020,000 to \$38,220,000 and decrease revenues to the Oil Extraction Tax Trust Fund approximately \$4,670,000 to \$6,370,000 for the 1983-85 biennium. This projection assumes current ownership and production patterns. If working interest ownership patterns shifted toward independents under the influence of this bill or a similar law because of the obvious financial advantages for independents, revenue losses could be considerably greater than projected in this fiscal note.
