This bill would permit the Department, by rule, to set and collect reasonable fees for the issuance of permits, licenses, and approvals to discharge sewage, industrial wastes, or other wastes into state waters. The collected fees are to offset estimated loss of federal funds in the next biennium in the amount of \$75,000 per year or \$150,000 for the biennium. Fiscal impact upon 265 cities which represents approximately 62 percent of program effort is estimated to be \$46,500 or \$93,000 for the biennium. This user fee would allow the Department to continue present level of effort without requesting an increase in general fund monies to offset loss of federal funds.
