	Narrative: HOUSE BILL No. 1206 will increase commercial and private rated pilots and aviation mechanics airmen registration fees charged by the Aeronautics Commission from \$3.00 for a two-year registration to \$8.00 for a four year registration. The Bill also increases student pilot registration fees from \$1.50 to \$3.00 for each student pilot for each two-year registration or renewal thereof.	
	House Bill 1206 will affect 3,500 commercial and private rated pilots and aviation mechanics, and about 400 student pilots. The present law, if unchanged would generate about \$11,100 for the general fund in the 1983-1985 biennium; with the increased fees the revenue is estimated at \$29,200 to the general fund.	
	The Governor's Management Task Force recommended that the airmen registration fees be increased and extended over a longer period of time to reduce printing and mailing costs.	
	The Bill has an emergency clause because the Aeronautics Commission will renew all airmen registrations effective July 1, 1983 and will need several weeks before July 1, 1983 to prepare and mail the new forms, and issue the registrations.
