<u>Narrative</u> : Under this bill, the net fiscal effect on the state general fund for the biennium would be a decrease of \$12,900,000. This is based upon the amount projected to be collected from Federal Mineral Leasing revenue, as outlined in the Governor's budget.						
\$8,600,000 of this amount would be targeted for oil impact grants and \$4,300,000 to go to the loan fund. Since the amount in the loan fund would remain an asset of the state, the actual outlay would be the amount dedicated to grants. Since funds dedicated to impact grants are awarded to all political subdivisions levying a property tax that can demonstrate they are experiencing negative impact from oil development and have submitted requests for funding for projects that will alleviate that impact, it is impossible to determine beforehand how much of the \$8,600,000 will go to counties or cities, or school districts or townships, etc.
