Narrative:		
This bill would permit the Department of Health, by rule, to set and collect reasonable fees for the issuance of approvals for drinking water supply systems. There are approximately 700 approved drinking water systems, one-half of which are community public water supply systems. The collected fees are to offset estimated loss of federal funds in the amount of about \$60,000 per year or \$120,000 for the biennium.		
This user fee would allow the Department to continue present level of effort without requesting an increase in general fund monies to offset loss of federal funds.		
Although currently authorized under 61-28.1-04 (NDCC), no funds have been collected since sufficient federal funds have been available; hence, there is no negative impact on the current general fund.
