Narrative:

This bill deals with the mechanics for the distribution of state support for public elementary and secondary education and limitation interim funds of school districts.

A fiscal note cannot be estimated until a per pupil payment amount is attached to the bill.

The 24 mill deduct requirement would increase the amount deducted from pupil payments and eliminate state payments for some school districts and reduce the amount from state sources as follows:

.020 mills \times \$950,000,000 TV = \$19,000,000 X 2 = \$38,000,000 .024 mills X \$950,000,000 = \$22,800,000 X 2 = \$45,600,000

Thus, \$7,600,000 less would be required from state sources and need to be raised from local sources by school districts.
