The fiscal effect of SB 2350 will be to increase benefits paid by \$65,000 per year. This means that the Workmen's Compensation Fund will have to establish an additional reserve of \$900,000.					
The Workmen's Compensation Fund will experience an additional cash outflow for the biennium of \$130,000.					
However, it should be noted that it can be safely said that for every additional dollar in benefit paid out, there must be an additional dollar paid into the Fund, or a dollar that is not returned to employers in the form of premium reductions.
