Title XV of PL93-641, the Public Health Service Act, as amended by the Health Planning and Resources Development Amendment of 1979 (Public Law 96-79), provides for the termination of the designation agreement for the State Health Planning and Development Agency if it is determined that the provisions of the agreement are not being fulfilled by that agency. Since the Certificate of Need Program is a required function of the agency, it is possible that termination may be initiated by the Secretary of Health and Human Services.			
A termination could eventually affect the anticipated receipt by the Department of Health of federal funding for State Health Planning in the amount of \$561,800, and other Public Health Service programs totalling \$1,301,200, during the 1985-87 biennium.
