FISCAL IMPACT OF RECOMMENDED CHANGES TO LEGISLATIVE COMPENSATION AND EXPENSE REIMBURSEMENT

The following schedule details the fiscal impact during the 49th Legislative Assembly of the proposed changes to legislative compensation and expense reimbursement recommended by the Legislative Compensation Commission as a result of its study during the 1983-85 interim:

Changes in expense reimbursement and salary to members of the 49th Legislative Assembly:
