This bill would necessitate five temporary positions for receiving telephone calls and disseminating the required information, and return attempts to notify beekeepers. Peak spray periods would be June (grasshoppers); July and August (sunflower insects). The BEESITE program, through AGNET would be used to readily retrieve information on beekeepers and locations. The input of data into the program would take about three months of one full-time person.				
Also, three field positions would be required for enforcementgeneral compliance and investigation of complaints. Included is laboratory analysis. We have not included attorney costs for enforcement or lawsuits which may arise from this bill.
