Narrative:								
The provisions of HB 1565 would be met from interest accumulated in the Workmen's Compensation Fund in excess of prior actuarial assumptions. The Bureau currently has \$38 million in unallocated reserves; \$15.6 million would be allocated to cover anticipated payments under the provisions of this bill. Interest earnings on reserves allocated for adjusted benefits would be sufficient to fund the provisions of this bill for the second year of the biennium. If current interest rate levels are maintained in the market, original reserves set aside under provisions of this bill may be sufficient to fund adjusted benefit increases for the next several years, with no further allocation from unallocated reserves. Actual cash flow would reduce fund assets by \$689,000 for the first year of the biennium and \$826,000 for the second year of the biennium. Total cash outflow for the biennium is estimated to be \$1,515,000. Provisions of this bill would not mean higher Workmen's Compensation premiums for North Dakota employers.
