	Narrative:								
	We project that with our present cash balance and accounts receivable, that no additional loan funds will be needed to administer the Veterans Aid Loan Fund through the coming biennium if Senate Bill 2089 becomes law. However, that could change in the following biennium depending upon our experience in the 1985-87 biennium.  We estimate an additional 68 loans to be granted each year (136 for the biennium) at a maximum loan to each of \$2,000 for a total of \$272,000 for the 1985-87 biennium if this law is passed, making peacetime veterans eligible for Veterans Aid Loans.  As of November 30, 1984, we had a cash balance of \$233,646.85 and \$326,507.17 in accounts receivable, for a total of \$560,154.02 in our permanent revolving fund of the Veterans Aid Fund.  If this bill is passed, there may also be a fiscal impact involving the Soldiers Home at Lisbon.
