<pre>Narrative:</pre>
The exact fiscal impact of this bill cannot be estimated at this time. However, the following general statements can be made:  Section 1 of the engrossed bill, relating to the lowering of the holding period of various bank deposits, should result in a very slight increase in the income distributions from the common schools trust fund. A very rough estimate would be that the trust fund would increase by \$100,000 to \$500,000 as the result of this change, with the income earned on these additional funds being distributed yearly to the school districts.  Sections 2 and 3 of the engrossed bill, relating to the lowering of the aggregate amount, will result in a slight increase in the advertising and other administrative costs of the Department. However, these changes will result in more funds being returned to the rightful owner.  Section 4 of the engrossed bill, relating to the sale of certain property presumed
abandoned, will result in a very slight increase in the income distributed to the common schools.
Section 5 of the engrossed bill will prevent unreasonable expenses to the fund. Section 6 of the engrossed bill will have no fiscal impact.
