The revenue generated from license fees would be directed to the Workmen's Compensation Fund, as are other boiler licensing fees. After the first year's operation, it is estimated that the license fee cost of \$25.00 per license will offset the expenses of the program. However, the Bureau anticipates that an additional \$50,000 in one-time start up costs would be necessary in order to avoid the impact on the employers' Fund at the Bureau. The Bureau's boiler inspector estimates that 4,000 operators would eventually procure licenses at \$25.00 per license, thus generating \$100,000 in potential annual income. Expenses of administering this program would include another boiler inspector as a minimum. A half-time secretary would also be needed.
