Narrative:

REVENUE: This bill essentially changes the gaming tax computation from 5% of the adjusted gross proceeds to 1% of the gross proceeds. Also, the bill requires that the attorney general monitor the planned and actual use of the gaming enforcement funds paid back to the counties and cities.

> The bill's gaming tax computation would result in \$345,564 being received as additional revenue during the biennium for the general fund. Note, this amount represents only 60% of the actual gaming tax received since 40% of the tax is paid back to the counties and cities for gaming enforcement purposes.

EXPENSE:

An expense of \$41,650 would be incurred to modify the existing gaming computer programs and to fund salaries and fringe benefits for one-half of one auditor I position and related operating and equipment expenses to accommodate the provisions of this bill.
