dollars. It is expected that a subscription to North Dakota History would be the major benefit to members and that all current subscribers would be designated as members. Publication costs are included in our present budget. The only potential impact would be if subscribers increased substantially beyond the present level. As with current subscription fees, membership dues would be deposited in the general fund. Membership dues would be set at a level to offset benefits, the only problem being that these funds would be available for increased costs only through the appropriation process. The same computerized mailing list presently used for subscribers will be used for memberships, and promotional materials for North Dakota History subscriptions would be expanded to include membership promotion.

It is therefore anticipated there will be no additional fiscal impact unless a dramatic increase in persons wishing membership as opposed to those who now have subscriptions would occur. Such an impact cannot be accurately predicted at this time. In any case, it is expected that revenues would offset cost.
