Narrative:
Senate Bill No. 2124 makes permanent the statute passed by the 1985 Legislative Assembly (effective only through June 30, 1987) which provides that transportation costs for students at the School for the Deaf be paid totally by the School for the Deaf.
Prior to the 1985-86 school year, the students at the School for the Deaf averaged 5-6 weekend trips home for the year. The School now is able to transport children home each weekend at an overall savings to both the State general fund and to local school districts. The Department of Public Instruction and local school districts previously were responsible for the transportation costs on a 60% - 40% matching basis. Based on this formula, during the 1981-83 biennium, DPI's cost of \$108,720 (general fund) and local school districts paid \$72,480.
The School for the Deaf's 1987-89 executive budget includes \$238,080 (general fund) for the student transportation program. However, the School's budget flects a reduction of approximately \$210,000 (general fund) as savings resulting from closing the School on weekends.
Therefore, the net increase in the School for the Deaf's budget of \$28,080 represents a savings of \$80,640 in general fund when compared to DPI's 1981-83 cost of \$108,720. Also, school districts would again save \$72,480.
