If enacted, SB 2181 would allow the attorney general's office, a general fund agency, to bill and to collect monies from special fund agencies for legal services rendered. Such monies would be deposited into the attorney general's operating fund. Thus, there would be no income directly into the general fund, although the funding of the attorney general's office by the general fund would be reduced accordingly.
